1. Call to Order and Introductions by Lisa Norton, Chief Administrative Officer (CAO) of the Confederated Tribes of Siletz

CAO of the Confederated Tribes of Siletz Lisa Norton called the meeting to order. Attending were CAO Norton, Commissioner Hall, Commissioner Miller, Commissioner Jacobson (remote), County Counselor Yuille (remote), Siletz Mayor Wormon, Committee Member Wylie Stokes.

2. Election of Siletz Budget Committee Officers

A. Chair – CAO Norton nominated Mayor Worman as chair. Commissioner Hall seconded. Motion carried.

B. Secretary - Commissioner Hall nominated Commissioner Miller as secretary. CAO Norton seconded the motion. Motion carried.

Chair Wormon opened the public hearing.

3. Meeting of the Siletz Area Enhanced Law Enforcement District Budget Committee to present the Budget Message and to take public comment on the Siletz Area Enhanced Law Enforcement District Budget for FY 2023-2024 – Presented by: Budget Officer Christina Shearer and Sheriff Curtis Landers and Patrol Commander, Lieutenant Karl Vertner

Sheriff Landers presented an overview of the Siletz Enhanced Law Enforcement District budget. Lt. Vertner reviewed recent successes, including community events, cooperative efforts with the Confederated Tribe of Siletz, and ongoing monthly meetings with stakeholders. Sheriff Landers reviewed expenses and revenues and the number and types of calls for service. He informed the committee of the recent arbitration, which will have an impact on the budget. Lt. Vertner reviewed goals for 2023-2024. Discussion with the committee centered around public promotion and transparency of the activities of the Sheriff's Office in Siletz.

4. Audience Input/Testimony – There was no audience input or testimony.

5. Motion on Siletz Area Enhanced Law Enforcement District Budget – Commissioner Hall moved to approve the Siletz Area Enhanced Law Enforcement Service District FY 2023-24 budget as submitted to this Committee and to authorize a property tax levy at the permanent tax rate of \$1.31 (one dollar and 31 cents) per thousand and that these taxes be imposed and categorized for the tax year 2023-24 upon the assessed

value on all taxable property within the District in accordance with law as of July 1, 2023. CAO Norton seconded the motion. Motion carried.
