I. CALL TO ORDER

Chair Fullmer called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

II. ROLL CALL - ESTABLISHMENT OF A QUORUM

In addition to Chair Fullmer, Budget Committee member Cristen Don was present, as well as Commissioners Chuck, Hall, and Miller. A quorum was established. Chair Fullmer disclosed for the record that he is the Executive Director for the Waldport Chamber of Commerce, which has received in the past, and may receive in the future, grant funds from the County. He made this statement in an effort to be transparent about any conflict of interest.

A. Motion on Elected Officials Compensation

Cristen Don moved to approve the recommendations of the Lincoln County Compensation Board for elected officials compensation commencing July 1, 2025. Commissioner Miller seconded. The motion passed. Chair Fullmer recessed the Lincoln County budget meeting.

B. Motion on Animal Services District Budget

Chair Fullmer convened the hearing on the Lincoln County Animal Services District Budget. Commissioner Chuck moved to approve the Lincoln County Animal Services District FY 2025-26 Budget as submitted to this Committee and to authorize a property tax levy at the permanent tax rate of \$0.11 (11 cents) per thousand and that these taxes be imposed and categorized for the tax year 2025-26 upon the assessed value on all taxable property within the county in accordance with law as of July 1, 2025. Commissioner Hall seconded the motion. The motion carried. Chair Fullmer closed the hearing.

C. Motion on Lincoln County Extension Service District Budget

Chair Fullmer convened the hearing for the Lincoln County Extension Service District Budget. There was no public comment. Cristen Don moved to approve the Lincoln County Extension Service District FY 2025-26 Budget as submitted to this Committee and to authorize a property tax levy at the permanent tax rate of \$0.0451 (4.51 cents) per thousand and that these taxes be imposed and categorized for the tax year 2025-26 upon the assessed value on all taxable property within the county in accordance with law as of July 1, 2025. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried. Chair Fullmer closed this hearing.

D. Motion on the Siletz Area Enhanced Law Enforcement District Budget

This item was mistakenly placed on the agenda. This matter was decided on May 29, 2025.

E. Motion on Solid Waste Disposal Service District Budget

Commissioner Hall moved to approve the Lincoln County Solid Waste Disposal Service District 2025-26 Budget as submitted to this Committee. Commissioner Chuck seconded the motion. The motion carried. Chair Fullmer closed this hearing.

F. Motion on Transportation Services District Budget

Chair Fullmer opened the hearing on the Lincoln County Transportation Services District Budget. Commissioner Chuck moved to approve the Lincoln County Transportation Service District 2025-26 Budget as submitted to this Committee and to authorize a property tax levy at the permanent tax rate of \$0.0974 (9.74 cents) per thousand and that these taxes be imposed and categorized for the tax year 2025-26 upon the assessed value on all taxable property within the county in accordance with law as of July 1, 2025. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried. Chair Fullmer closed this hearing.

G. Motion on Lincoln County Budget

Chair Fullmer reconvened the Lincoln County Budget hearing. Commissioner Hall moved to approve the Lincoln County FY 2025-26 Budget as submitted to this Committee, and to authorize a property tax levy at the permanent tax rate of \$2.8202 per thousand for general operations, and that these taxes be imposed and categorized for the tax year 2025-26 upon the assessed value on all taxable property within the county in accordance with law as of July 1, 2025. Commissioner Miller seconded the motion. The motion carried.
